

## Environmental Conformity Declaration

We, Celltech Abatel AB, declare under our sole responsibility that the products sold and delivered by Celltech Abatel AB to which this declaration relates are in compliance with the following relevant directives, regulations or other normative documents:

### EC regulation No. 1907/2006 - REACH

#### Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals

Batteries are considered as articles, not substances, under REACH and are therefore not subjected to the REACH registration requirements.

Any producer of an article containing a Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) on the 'Candidate List' in a concentration above 0.1 % (w/w) has the duty to provide the recipient of the article with sufficient information to allow safe use of the article.

Based on communication with our suppliers, Celltech Abatel AB lithium ion battery products are not known to contain at >0.1% w/w of any of the substances on the SVHC Candidate List.

Products sold and delivered by Celltech Abatel AB comply with European directives 2011/65/EU, RoHS 2 and 2015/863/EU, RoHS 3.

### EU directive 2006/66/EC - Battery Directive

Celltech Abatel AB battery products comply with the substance restrictions set forth in the Battery directive and contain <0.0005% mercury (Hg), <0.0020 cadmium (Cd) and <0.0040% lead (Pb). The chemical symbols Hg, Cd and Pb are therefore not required below the separate collection symbol.

Celltech Abatel AB acknowledge the responsibility to be a registered producer (as defined by the directive) and has since October 2005 reported quantities of sold batteries.
